Arrival & Dismissal

Breakfast will be served from 7:20 a.m. to 7:45 a.m. Classroom instruction begins promptly at 7:45 a.m. Our scholars will be considered tardy if they arrive after 7:45 a.m. Any student arriving after 7:45 a.m. will be marked tardy. Students arriving tardy must be accompanied by an adult to be signed in. The school day concludes at 3:15 p.m.

School Meals Program Free

Starting this school year, we will be participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP), a meal service option offered by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), allowing us to provide meals at no cost to all of our students.

Dress Code

Students may wear any solid-colored polo shirt, either long or short sleeve. Sweatshirts, hoodies, and zip-up jackets are permitted; however, hoods must be removed while inside the school building. Acceptable bottoms include black, navy, or khaki skirts, skorts, jumpers, shorts, or slacks. **Colored denim is not permitted.** Tennis shoes are required.

Huron Sports Academy-branded apparel, whether provided by the school or purchased by families will be considered part of the uniform.

Students who are not in compliance with the dress code will receive a verbal warning and a notice will be sent home. Continued violations may result in direct parent contact.

Our goal is to keep students focused and in class. Please ensure your child arrives at school dressed appropriately each day.

School Closing Announcements

There are often situations in which it is necessary to close the school. Huron Sports Academy airs school closings on local news channels. We typically close to inclement weather along with the local school districts; however, occasionally we find the weather conditions too harsh for our children during times when the Public Schools remain open.
