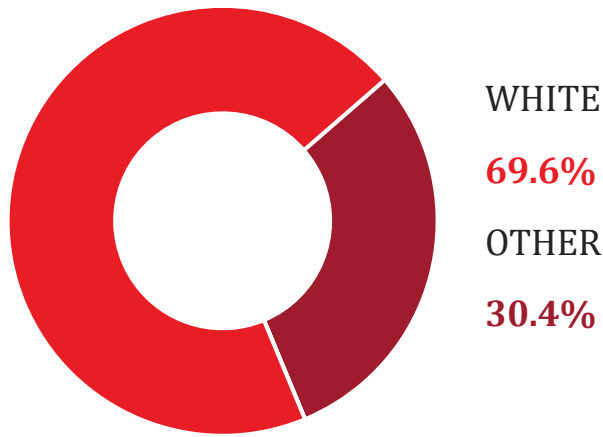

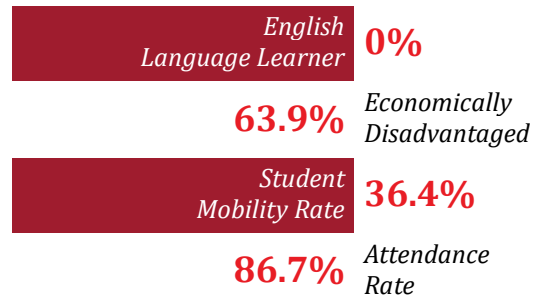


## Student Demographics

## Progress towards Goals

Huron Sports Academy was a Year 1 school in 2024-25. Due to enrollment numbers, all state assessments were not calculated. In **Reading** (iReady), K-4 students demonstrating progress at or above the annual typical growth rate was **133%**. In **Math** (iReady), **172%** of K-4 students are demonstrating progress at or above the annual typical growth rate.

- By FY2028, the overall percentage of students reaching proficiency or above on state tests in **Mathematics** will increase by **20%**.

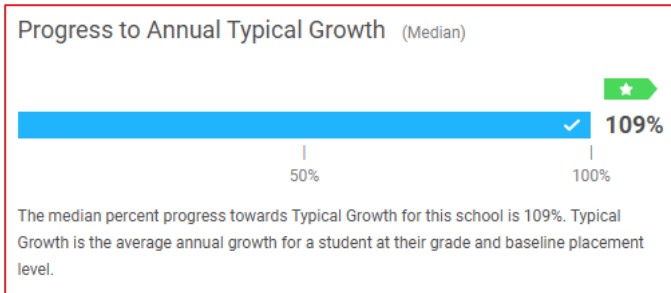

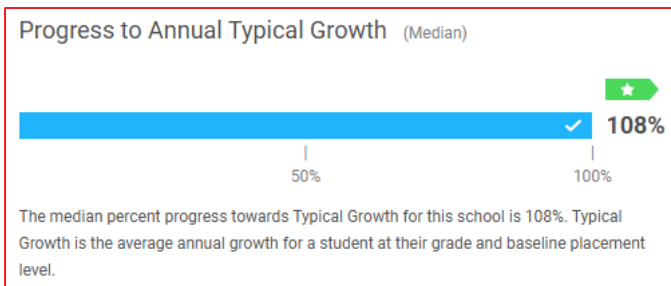




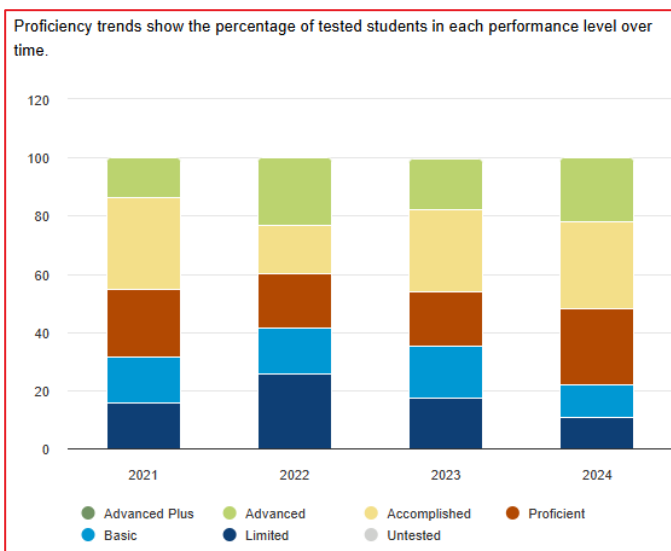
## iReady Data Reading
